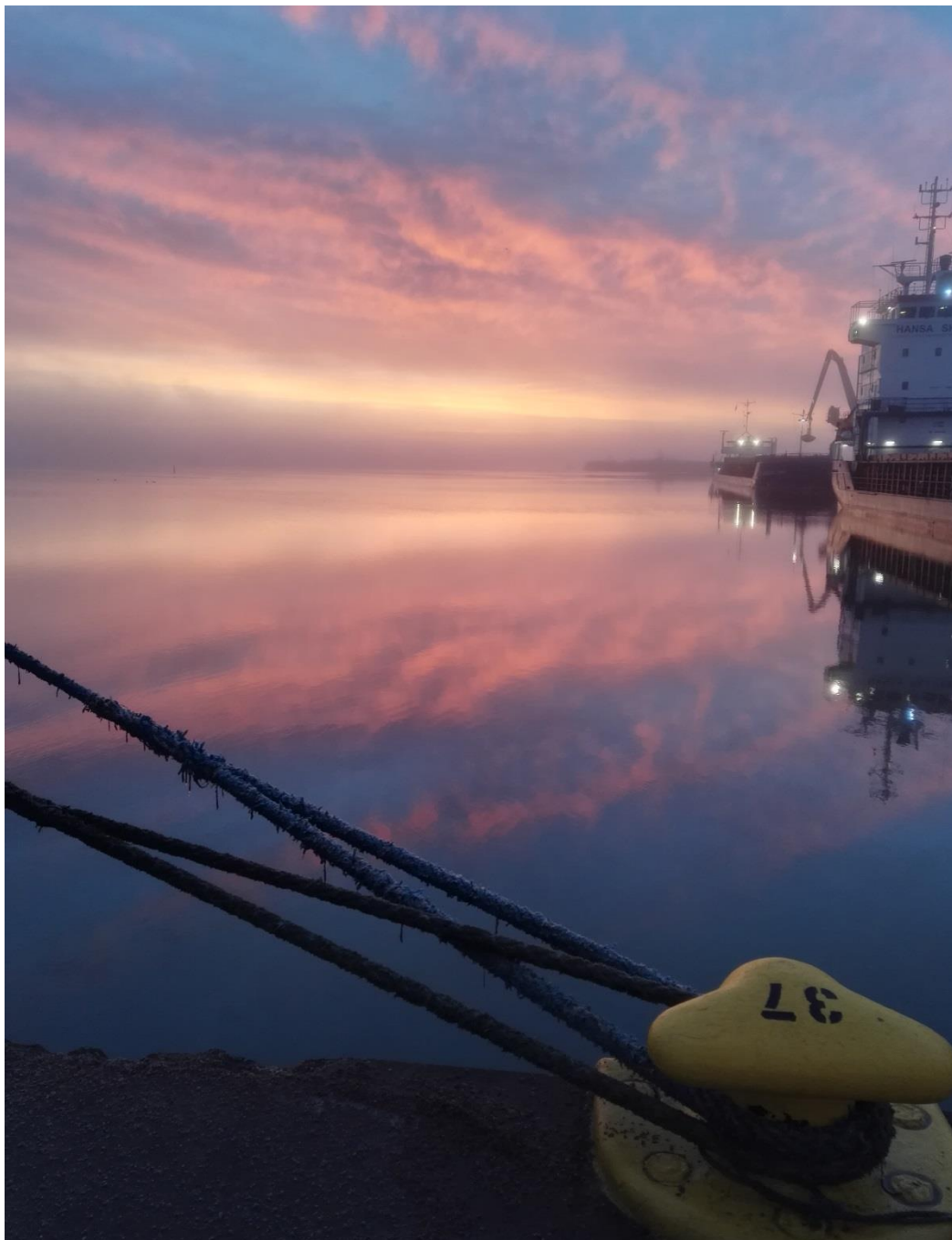

1. Introduction

This price list is valid from January 1, 2020 and until further notice. The tariffs are based on established agreements with the labor party and applicable state fees.

The fee is charged in SEK and the invoiced amount must be delivered to Mälarhamnar within 30 days from the invoice date. Delay interest is invoiced according to the invoice if payment is not made at the latest due date.

When a vessel first calls at Mälarhamnar, or if the vessel has been rebuilt since the last call, a valid survey letter according to the 1969 measurement rules shall be presented by the shipping company or the shipping company's representative.

Mälarhamnar exempts itself from any liability and liability for damage or expense that arises as a result of strike, blockade, lockout, weather or other obstacles outside the company's control.

All assignments are performed according to the Swedish Harbor Terminal Regulations 1989.

Handlings when documentation about the cargo is of importance shall be given to Mälarhamnar AB.

Water must be ordered in conjunction with ship registration, no later than 24h before expected delivery. If water needs are not announced, a basic fee of SEK 1 000 + hourly wage is charged for each hour started for "worker" according to 4. Personnel and Machines

13. Waste

Sludge, oil-contaminated water and ship-generated waste are included in the port rate.

Ship-generated waste left in port must be sorted into the following fractions:

- Waste oil from ship's engine room (sludge and oil-contaminated tap water)
- Oil residue and oil-contaminated flushing fluid.
- Chemical charge residues and chemical contaminated flushing water.
- Other cargo residues
- Lavatory waste

Solid waste sorted in the following fractions:

- Hazardous waste (batteries, fluorescent lamps, paint, solvents, etcetera)
- Electronics
- Combustible waste (including food waste)
- Other waste such as corrugated cardboard

13.1 Enviromental discount

Vessels or shipping companies that can show that they reduce the amount of waste in an environmentally and lawfully correct way, can receive a discount corresponding to the fee associated with the fee charged to the type of waste. The discount is obtained by signing a special agreement with Mälarhamnar AB.

Vessels that have fully delivered their sludge to the previous port in Europe and who can prove this by showing receipt receive a discount of 0.05 SEK per gross ton.

13.2 Extra charge

An additional fee is charged for the additional costs incurred by Mälarhamnar AB as follows:

- a) If "Notification of delivery of waste from vessels" has not been made in time in accordance with Swedish law the Swedish Maritime Administration's regulations.
- b) If the port is not notified of the contents of foreign substances, solvents or detergents in sludge, or if barrels and packages of oil residues or hazardous waste are not properly packaged and labeled with contents or if the delivery does not take place at designated places.
- c) If the ship does not provide personnel when delivering sludge.
- d) If the pump capacity for sludge is less than 5 kbm / h.
- e) If the ship delivers scrap waste, the actual cost is charged based on quantity and content.

13.3 Exceptions

Exceptions to the above can be made after agreement with waste recipients. The waste recipient is SUEZ Recycling AB.

At the Nordkalk- and Cement quay in Köping no fee is paid if vessels or shipping companies themselves handle sludge disposal and other waste. Permission for this is required from the Swedish Maritime Administration.

14.1 Ordering and cancellation

Tugboats are ordered during regular working hours and at least 3 hours before the execution of each assignment.

Cancellation must be made no later than 3 hours before booked towing. For later cancellation 70% will be charged.

14.2 Towing material

The towed vessel provides tow ropes.

14.4 Liability

All work is performed according to Scandinavian Tugowners' Association's standard terms.

- The company is not liable for any damage caused to the client in connection with the assignment unless the damage is a consequence of errors or omissions of the company's management.

- b) The company does not respond to errors or omissions committed by a person in the company's management as a master of a tugboat or a member of its crew.
- c) The client cannot in any case demand compensation from the tug master or member of its crew or pilot or anyone else who is in the service of the company.
- d) In no case shall the company's liability exceed 100 000 SEK.
- e) The client shall compensate for any damage incurred by the company in connection with the assignment, unless he proves that neither he nor anyone for whom he responds by mistake or negligence wholly or partly caused the damage.
- f) If the company is held in connection with the assignment responsible for damage caused to third parties, the client shall indemnify the company without damages unless the damage has arisen in such circumstances, that the company would have been liable to the client if the damage affected it.
